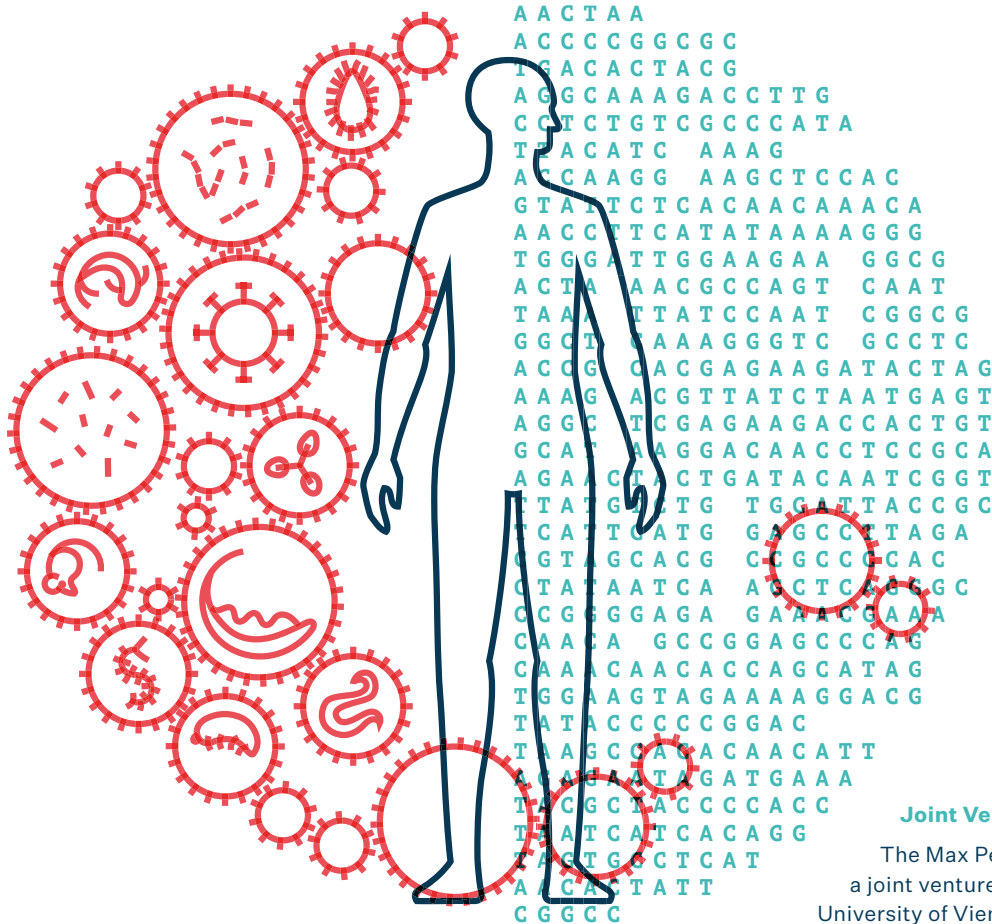


Mission Statement

The Max Perutz Labs were founded in 2005 as a joint venture of the University of Vienna and the Medical University of Vienna.



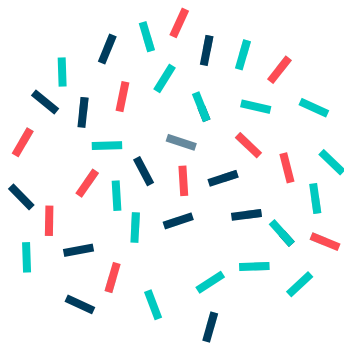

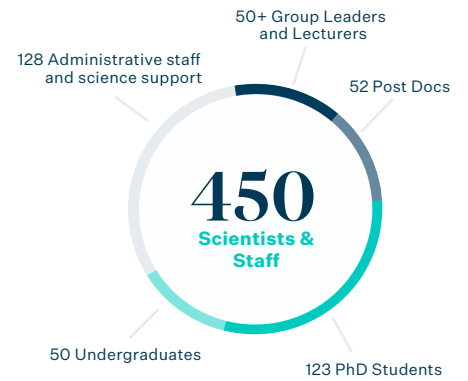
